Supplies needed for at-home study	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 12" ruler• Math-on-Call (math resource book) (by Andrew Kaplan, Houghton Mifflin, Publishers)
MATH	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• A strong 3-ring binder that goes back and forth from home to school DAILY (1.5" or larger)• 3 dividers for the binder• Graph paper / Notebook paper for the binder• 6" ruler for the pencil pouch in the binder• Colored pencils or gel pens for correcting• Scientific (NOT graphing) calculator--about \$15 (for home and study hall use)• A separate 3 hole punched case or pencil box to hold Math supplies (calculator, pencils, etc.).
FOREIGN LANGUAGE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1.5" binder (French only)• 5 dividers (French only)• Composition notebook (Spanish only)
SCIENCE & SOCIAL STUDIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1.5" 3 ring binder with one section for each of these subjects.• Dividers with pockets are helpful
ELA	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 1 " binder kept in-class for their portfolio• 2 Pocket Folders (two)
