- ☑ 2 Black or blue pens
 - ☑ 2 Colored Pens (green, purple, or red) used for peer editing
 - ☑ Pencils and extra eraser caps (plan on a box of pencils per month)
 - ☑ Colored pencils
 - ☑ Non-electric personal pencil sharpener (like Staples "Dual Dome")
 - ☑ 2-3 different colored highlighters
 - ☑ 2 packs of loose leaf paper
 - ☑ 1 sturdy plastic pocket folder for homework (some students prefer an accordion folder)
 - ☑ Binders- **Either** :
 - One large 3-ring binder 3" or bigger (This is recommended if your child has a tendency towards disorganization- "trapper" style ok)
 - OR Two 1.5-2inch 3 ring binders
 - ☑ Students should have their 5th grade World Language binder. If that didn't survive, they need a 1" 3 ring binder for French/Spanish
 - ☑ Post-its 1 ½ x 2 or 3x3 are fine
 - ☑ 15 Tab dividers
 - ☑ 1 spiral bound 4-subject notebook (for notes)
 - ☑ 2 ultra thin black Sharpies
 - ☑ 1GB USB "key" or "thumb" drive for saving on laptops and transferring information between home and school
 - ☑ 1-2 boxes tissues
 - ☑ 1 box of microwave popcorn for after school help times
