# Communication Skills

---

- Students learn the 8 guidelines to being a clear and effective communicator
  - **L**isten to the entire message
  - **E**ye contact
  - **A**void distractions
  - **D**on't interrupt
  - **S**peak loudly and clearly
  - **T**hink before you speak
  - **A**sk questions about the topic
  - **R**epeat the message
- Time is spent defining assertive, aggressive and passive behavior
- Initiatives and language address the issue of bullying



# Solo

---

- Students are tasked with defining what qualities they strive to develop in themselves
- Emphasis is placed on defining a goal and mapping out a strategy to meet that goal
- **SMART Goal Setting**
  - **S**pecific
  - **M**easurable
  - **A**ttainable
  - **R**ealistic
  - **T**imely
