Program Title: Falmouth High School Tutoring Center	School/Grade Levels: 9-12	
Brief Program Description: <p>The tutoring center was set up in order to provide a variety of supportive service to students. Some of the students receive RTI instruction, some students are referred by the student center team, others voluntarily receive tutorial services as they see fit on a drop-in/as needed basis.</p> <p>The tutoring center is staffed with a half-time teacher and by 2 ed-tech III's. Students are also served by 60 volunteer student tutors. One ed- tech focuses on math tutorial and the other on literacy. The tutorial center is located in what used to be the ATM room behind the librarian's desk.</p> <p>The students are able to drop into the tutorial center anytime during the day as well as one half hour before and one half hour after school.</p>		
Program Purpose: <p>To increase students basic academic skills, to provide long and short term tutorial instruction, to give students more options for supportive study time, for projects, test preparation etc.</p>		
Program Objectives: <p>Increase student success across all subject areas as determined by students and teachers</p>
