

PUBLISHING STUDENT WORK ON THE FALMOUTH PUBLIC SCHOOLS WEB SITE

Allowing students to publish work on the web provides students the opportunity to share their work with others and promotes communication skills. Student work and photos/digital video images are published under the following guidelines:

- The student's first name and last initial only will be used in published student work.
 - Digital images of students will not include identifying information.
 - Under no circumstances will a student's home address or phone number be included.
 - If replies to published student work are appropriate, the sponsoring teacher's address will be the e-mail address displayed, not the student's.
 - In special circumstances (such as the ThinkQuest contest for 12 to 18 year olds) last name or e-mail may be added. This requires a separate parent-signed release.
 - All web pages created by students and student organizations on the district's computer system will be subject to treatment as district-sponsored publications.
 - The web master will check class web sites for adherence to standards before publishing.
